Nose: The snuffly infant and snotty toddlers (Infant rhinitis, allergic rhinitis, piriform stenosis, choanal atresia, adenoid hypertrophy, intranasal steroids)

- Nose: Nasal obstruction in kids Septoturbs and FESS? Rhinoplasty? 1100 (CF, PCD, septum & turbinate disease, cleft palate, sinusitis, etc.)
- 1130 Nose: Epistaxis, nasal tumours, orbital complications (JNA, HHT)
- 1200 Throat: Snoring vs OSA? (Non-obstructive sleep disorder, oximetry, sleep study, DISE, behaviour assessment and non-surgical management.)

- 1330 Airway: Drooling & Aspiration (Medical and Surgical treatment of drooling, assessment of aspiration)
