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KEYNOTE SPEAKERS



Dr Catherine K Hart

United States of America

Dr Catherine K. Hart is a Professor of Otolaryngology-Head and Neck Surgery and Division Director of Pediatric Otolaryngology at Cincinnati Children's. She specialises in the management of paediatric airway stenosis and complex aerodigestive disorders. Her research focuses on advancing the surgical management of airway stenosis and aerodigestive disorders in children with CHARGE syndrome.



Dr Kazuhiro Omura

Japan

Dr Omura graduated from the Jikei University School of Medicine Tokyo JAPAN in 2004, after completing a short-term exchange at the St. Thomas Hospital in the United Kingdom as an exchange student with the selected grant from the Jikei University. An initial clinical internship started at the Asahi General Hospital and a fellow in the Otorhinolaryngology department in 2006 with a short-term exchange doctor at UCLA in 2006.

Since 2009, he has been admitted to the otorhinolaryngology department of the Jikei University School of Medicine. Dr Omura reports seventeen novel surgical techniques out of over 70 international papers and has transmitted its techniques of endoscopic approach to tumors in the nasal cavity, skull base, to the world as well as Japan. His operational number of endoscopic approach for sinonasal malignant tumor is the highest in Japan and he has been invited as an operator from National Cancer Center Japan and many universities.



Dr Peter Santa Maria

United States of America

Peter Santa Maria, MBBS PhD is Professor and Chief of Otolaryngology & Neurotology and Vice Chair of Translational & Clinical Research at the University of Pittsburgh, where he also serves as Co-Director of Pitt SPARK and Director of Faculty Innovation.

Originally trained in Australia, he completed his MBBS and PhD at the University of Western Australia and was supported early in his career by a prestigious Garnett Passe and Rodney Williams Surgeon-Scientist Award, which launched his pioneering work in tympanic membrane regeneration.



Dr Maie St John

United States of America

A highly renowned surgeon, scientist and educator, Dr St. John is Andelot Professor and Director of the Department of Otolaryngology-Head Neck Surgery, Otolaryngologist-in-Chief, Johns Hopkins Medicine. She is the immediate past Professor and Chair of the Department of Head and Neck Surgery and Professor of Bioengineering at UCLA where she held the Thomas C. Calcaterra, M.D., Chair in Head and Neck Surgery and Co-Director of the UCLA Head and Neck Cancer Program. Under her leadership, the Department of Head & Neck Surgery at UCLA rose to #1 nationally by USNWR. Dr St. John's laboratory studies the mechanisms of tumor progression and metastasis, incorporating the results of their laboratory-based research into the development of novel therapeutics. She is an outstanding educator who has provided mentorship to numerous trainees and serves as a member of several prestigious organisations including the Executive Council of the AHSN, Triological Society, ACS Board of Governors Advisory Council, and the American Laryngological Association. She is a senior examiner for the ABOto and a reviewer for the AAO-HNS CORE grants, and NIH/NIDCR, NCI and NIBIB study sections. She has been the recipient of multiple awards for teaching and research.

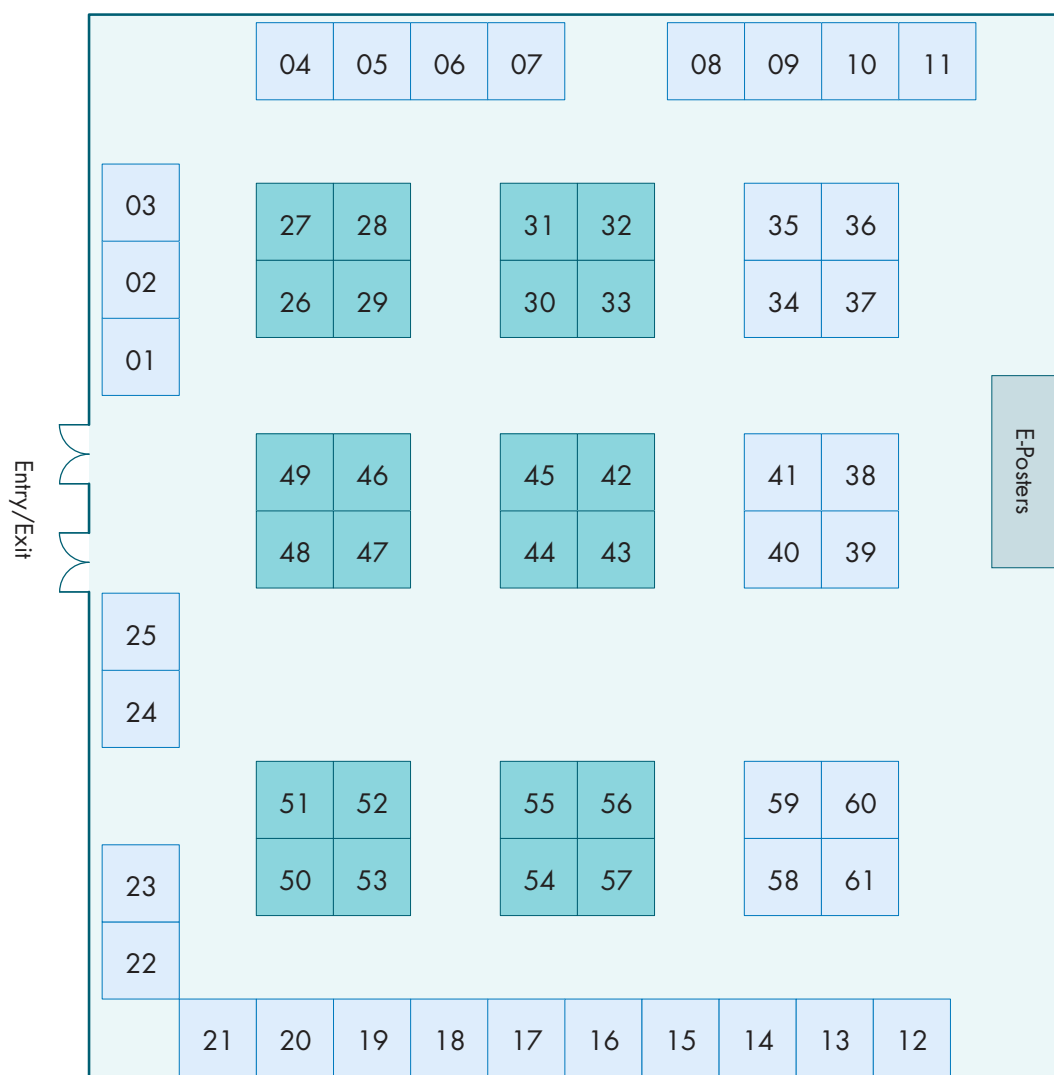
