

The 44th South Australian Intensive Care Fellowship Exam (Tub's) Course

Online Registration - OPEN: **2nd September 2025, 10:00 am (SA time)**

The 2026 course will be held: **11-13th February 2026**.

It will be based at **Ayers House** in the centre of Adelaide, with Hot Cases at the Royal Adelaide Hospital (RAH), Queen Elizabeth Hospital, Flinders Medical Centre and Lyell McEwin Hospital.

It is specifically aimed at trainees sitting for the CICM Fellowship Examination, and is strictly limited to those planning to sit the exam in 2026.

The Course runs for 3 days and has a very practical and interactive focus. It includes tutorials on the written examination, vivas and hot cases, as well as running mock examinations in each of these. All candidates will do trial hot cases at 2 different hospitals.

Please note that the course contains little didactic teaching, and the intention is not to teach core knowledge in intensive care medicine. The focus is very much on preparation for the exam, and so a significant degree of knowledge and exam practice is assumed prior to attending the course.

Over 30 Faculty are involved, including several from interstate, and many are current or past examiners.

The cost is **AUD\$1500**.

Positions on the course are strictly limited and will be allocated on a first-come-first-served basis from **2nd September 2025, 10:00 am** (Australian Central Standard Time, ACST).

N.B. applications for the course **will not** be accepted before this date and should be made online (at **saica.com.au**)

Please note that payment **MUST be made by 30th September 2025**, or that person's position will be offered to another applicant – as the course is invariably oversubscribed. Once payment has been made, cancellations on or prior to 3rd December 2025 will be refunded at a rate of 50%. Cancellations after 3rd December 2025 will not be refunded.

There are a number of good hotels close to the venue.

The Course Dinner is on the Thursday night of the course (February 12) and the cost is included in the registration fee.

Lunch, morning and afternoon tea will be provided throughout the Course, except when off-site doing Hot Cases.
