Cardiothoracic Advanced Life Support (CALS) provider training prepares team members in the management of cardiac arrest following cardiac surgery, using an evidence-based protocol.

The course combines didactic sessions with hands-on practical workshops and high fidelity simulation.

Course modules include:

- Principles of resuscitation after cardiac surgery
- Assessment and management of the deteriorating post-surgical patient
- Temporary cardiac pacing
- Emergency re-sternotomy
- Human factors impacting resuscitation success
