OVERVIEW

- This course is now a prerequisite for Intensive Care Trainees by CICM
- The purpose of this course is to enable the participant to implement the principles of ongoing management of critically ill children in the post-resuscitation and stabilisation phase
- Designed for current critical care healthcare professionals, and those that provide paediatric resuscitation and early intensive care management to critically ill children
- The 2-day interactive course utilises multimodal teaching (lectures, hands-on workshops and simulation sessions) to cover the fundamental aspects of Paediatric Critical Care
- Delivered by PICU guest lecturers, clinical experts and mentors
